Baptisms are celebrated the 2nd Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Parents should register in the parish before scheduling a Baptism. To schedule a Baptism, please call our office two months prior to the Baptism. A class is typically required for parents preparing for Baptism.

## HOLY MATRIMONY

To celebrate your Marriage at Corpus Christi, please call the parish office for details. Corpus Christi follows the Marriage requirements of the Diocese of Trenton which requires arrangements to be made one year in advance. *If you are civilly married, but not Sacramentally married in the Church, please call the parish office to have your Marriage recognized by The Church.*
